### Award Description

This award recognizes an athlete who competed in an individual or team sport in 2024, after having suffered an unusual and significant setback (i.e. illness, injury, etc.)

### Criteria

- Nominees will be judged for their performance in 2024;
- Eligible athletes are those who have resided in British Columbia for the 2024 calendar year or those who received the majority of their sport development in British Columbia before relocating;
- Nominees will be considered on the basis of their amateur performance only, by definition of the respective Provincial Sport Organization;
- Sport BC member organizations may submit only one (1) nominee in this category.

### Submission Requirements

- Fully completed nomination packages must include, and not exceed 5 pages total:
  - Completed nomination form
  - Four (4) photos of the nominee (headshot/action) in high-definition quality in .jpeg format.
  - Supporting documentation is highly encouraged (ie: news articles, etc.)
