As a nonprofit community organization, we pride ourselves on fostering connection, development, and passion for the sport.

Position Summary:

The Assistant Ice Technician supports all aspects of ice production and maintenance at the Chilliwack Curling Club. This is a seasonal position averaging 35 hours per week with rotating split shifts, including early mornings, afternoons, and evenings. The role includes maintaining the ice surface, facility cleanliness, and ensuring equipment is properly maintained. The Assistant Ice Technician reports to the Head Ice Technician and works collaboratively with other departments to ensure a high-quality curling experience.

Key Responsibilities:

- - Scrape, clean, and pebble the ice surface daily in preparation for league play, bonspiels, rentals, and practice sessions.
- - Maintain the cleanliness of the ice area including garbage removal, tissue restocking, and general tidiness.
- - Support maintenance of ice equipment, including ice scrapers, nippers, and their respective blades.
- - Clean and maintain ice-level washrooms and change rooms by mopping floors, emptying garbage, and replenishing supplies.
- - Assist with general upkeep of the ice plant area and locker rooms.
- - Perform other duties as assigned by the Head Ice Technician or Operations Management.

Qualifications:

- - Curling Canada Ice Technician Certificate – Level 2 preferred.
- - Minimum 2 years of experience in curling club ice-making strongly preferred.



- - An IFO or RO certificate or willingness to work towards certification
- - Ability to work independently and as part of a team.
- - Strong attention to detail and physical stamina.
- - Availability for rotating early morning, afternoon, and evening shifts.
