

Call for Expressions of Interest - Rowing BC Board of Directors

Under Section 7.5 of the Rowing BC Bylaws, the Rowing BC Board of Directors has appointed a Nominating Committee to prepare a list of eligible candidates from which the Membership will elect a Treasurer and Director-At-Large, each for two-year terms, ensuring that every year there is an opportunity for board renewal. The election will occur during the Rowing BC Annual General Meeting on Thursday, November 13, 2025. The Nominating Committee is chaired by Rowing BC Director Stacy Mitchell.

Rowing BC delivers on its mandate through the work of its Board of Directors, staff members, committees, as well as with support from the broader rowing community in BC. Rowing BC has made significant progress on goals laid out in the <u>2022 - 2025 Strategic Plan</u>.

Rowing BC's organizational structure defines governance to be overseen by the Board, management overseen by the Executive Director and operations overseen by Staff and Committees. As a governing board, Directors are responsible for establishing strategic priorities and policy for Rowing BC. Board work can involve up to 6 hours a month.

Rowing BC is currently searching for individuals who can contribute to the organization with their developed skills in one or more of the following areas:

- Fundraising, Sponsorships and Partnerships
- Finance and Not-for-Profit Accounting
- Human Resources

Ideal candidates will have these skills combined with any of the following:

- A passion for sport
- Current or recent involvement in the rowing community
- Experience working with nonprofit boards
